Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

An Import Permit is required when using a paper or non-approved electronic CVI.

Official Identification is required and must be listed on the CVI

Individual ID:

USDA 840 EID Tag

USDA metal NUES Tag

State-assigned premises ID tag or USDA-approved premises ID tag with individual herd number.

Group ID (Feeder Swine Only):

A state-assigned premises tattoo or tag, or a USDA-approved premises tattoo or tag, is acceptable if ALL animals originate from the premises.

****Pseudorabies-vaccinated swine are not eligible for entry into South Dakota.****

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an approved auction market.
