Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) OR NPIP VS FORM 9-3 MUST ACCOMPANY ALL POULTRY ENTERING THE STATE

Poultry, Hatching Eggs, and Ratites (Birds used in production)

All poultry must be accompanied by:

A CVI and an import permit

OR

A NPIP VS 9-3 form and an [Annual Poultry Permit](#)

Call the Animal Industry Board for more information on NPIP

Non-Poultry (Pet birds, Raptors, etc.)

A CVI must accompany all non-poultry entering the state

An import permit is required

Individual identification must be listed on the CVI

(Tattoo, leg band, wing band, or microchip)

Exhibition Poultry

Official Identification is required.

Check with the venue for additional requirements.

Testing requirements:

U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Clean States



Avian Influenza:

A negative test is required for waterfowl within **TEN** days before entering the state.

Pullorum:

Negative test within 90 days before entering the state

OR

Originating from a **Pullorum-free flock**. Non-poultry are exempt.
