## A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

## Official Identification

Official ID required for all intact feeding and breeding animals over 18 months of age

**Approved ID** 

**USDA 840 EID Tag** 

USDA Metal NUES Tag if applied before Nov 5, 2024

## **Breeding Animals**

**Trichomoniasis** Requirements

Status of females must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, pregnant, or calf at side

Non-virgin open females are not allowed

Status of bulls must be listed on the CVI

Virgin or a negative Trich test statement

Bison are exempt from Trich testing

Cattle moving from an area that is not accredited as free of Bovine Tuberculosis

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas -- DSA (Greater Yellowstone Area)

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
