Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Official Identification

An import permit is required for all sexually intact cattle.

USDA 840 EID tag

USDA metal NUES tag if applied before Nov 5, 2024

Breeding Animals

See Trichomoniasis and Tuberculosis Requirements.

Status of females must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, pregnant, or calf at side

Non-virgin open females are not allowed

Status of bulls must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, or a negative Trich test statement

Influenza A Testing Requirements

Testing completed within 7 days of entering the state

Required number of animals:

Groups of 30 heads or less: all animals need to be tested

Groups larger than 30 head: at least 30 animals tested.

Movement

Direct to a slaughter plant

Can travel on an owner/ hauler statement. No testing needed

Direct to the auction market

Negative Influenza A virus test within 7 days

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas—<u>DSA</u> (Greater Yellowstone Area)
