

# ***Cattle - Dairy***

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



**A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE**

## **Official Identification**

An import permit is required for all sexually intact cattle.

USDA 840 EID tag

USDA metal NUES tag if applied before Nov 5, 2024

## **Breeding Animals**

See [Trichomoniasis](#) and [Tuberculosis](#) Requirements.

Status of females must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, pregnant, or calf at side

Non-virgin open females are not allowed

Status of bulls must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, or a negative Trich test statement

## **Influenza A Testing Requirements**

Testing completed within 7 days of entering the state

Required number of animals:

Groups of 30 heads or less: all animals need to be tested

Groups larger than 30 head: at least 30 animals tested.

## **Movement**

Direct to a slaughter plant

Can travel on an owner/ hauler statement. No testing needed

Direct to the auction market

Negative Influenza A virus test within 7 days
