CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection)

Must Include:

Consignor and Consignee name and address.

Movement permit number issued by the Animal Industry Board.

Official Identification is required.

Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD): One of the following Statements must appear on CVI -

"All Cervidae identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection originate from a certified CWD cervid herd."

OR

"All Cervidae identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection originate from a herd with the stated monitored status."

OR

"All Cervidae identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection are offspring from or originate from a herd in which all Cervidae have been kept for at least one year or into which they were born. There has been no exposure to or additions from any other source in the past year. There have been no diagnoses, signs, or epidemiologic evidence of CWD in this herd for the past year. Records and causes of death for the past year in this herd of origin are available to the state veterinarian."
