Additional Restrictions on Animal Movements



Equine Herpes Virus

Due to a multi-state outbreak of Equine Herpes Virus associated with multiple equine events, the use of the **EECVI** is currently disabled.

EQUINE EXPORTS:

- Please contact your veterinarian and the state of destination to ensure that you meet their import requirements for upcoming movements.

EQUINE IMPORTS:

- CVI must be written within 72 hours of travel
 - Temperature must be taken within 72 hours and recorded on the CVI.
 - Statement on the CVI: Not originating from a quarantine herd or premises on hold by SAHO (State Animal Health Official) and not showing clinical signs consistent with EHV-1 or EHM.
- The following equines are not eligible for importation:
 - Equines that may have been exposed to EHV-1 within 14 days before CVI inspection.
 - Equines exhibiting any clinical signs consistent with EHV-1 or EHM, including a fever.
 - Equines with direct or indirect contact with horses attending the November events in Texas or Oklahoma.

INTRASTATE EQUINE: Should follow the protocols above to prevent the spread of Equine Herpes Virus.
