Moving Requirements



Greater Yellowstone Area Designated Surveillance Areas (DSA) of Idaho, Montana, and Wyoming

Animals of all ages must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection stating that the animals originate from the DSA.

Official identification is required for all intact animals and must be listed on the CVI.

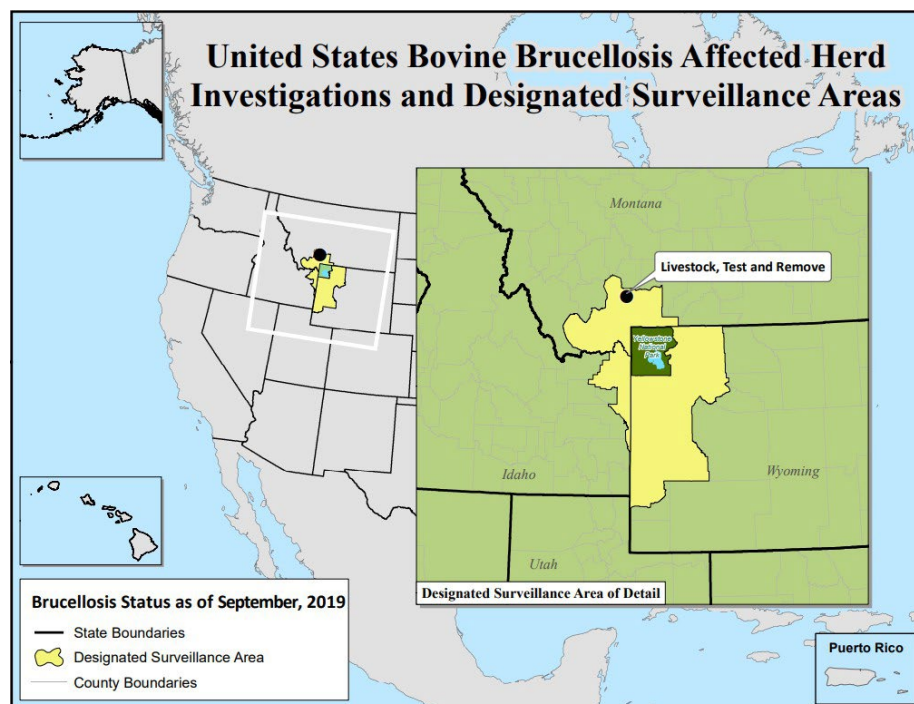
Heifers moving for feeding must be confined to prevent breeding.
