## Additional Requirements or Exceptions



### **A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE**

No Import Permit required for US-origin Equine

**EECVI** (Extended Equine Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) is approved in SD.

#### **Official ID**

Detailed Physical description, including any brands or lip tattoos.

Digital photographs are sufficient to identify the individual equine.

USDA-approved microchips.

Electronic Identification that complies with ISO 11784/11785.

#### **Coggins Requirements**

A negative Coggins or ELISA EIA test is required within 12 months before entry

Exceptions:

Native horses originating from North Dakota.

Foals traveling with their dam.

---

#### **Canadian Origin**

USDA import requirements must be met (**9 C.F.R 93.317**),

A South Dakota Import Permit is required.

**No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an approved auction market.**
