

Bovine - Exhibition or Rodeo



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Exhibition and Rodeo Cattle

Official ID required for all cattle imported for exhibition and rodeo, and must be listed on the CVI

Approved ID

USDA 840 EID Tag

USDA Metal NUES Tag if applied before Nov 5, 2024

Status of females must be listed on the CVI

Virgin, pregnant, or calf at side

Non-virgin open females are not allowed

Status of bulls must be listed on the CVI

Virgin or a negative Trich test statement

Testing Requirements

Tuberculosis:

All rodeo/recreational cattle must have a negative TB test conducted by a US-accredited veterinarian within 12 months of importation

Trichomoniasis:

All non-virgin bulls must have a negative Trich test

Exception: The bulls are confined to prevent breeding

Cattle moving from an area that is not accredited as free of Bovine Tuberculosis

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas -- DSA (Greater Yellowstone Area)
