RE: Federal Order Regarding Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in Livestock

USDA APHIS has published a federal order (<u>link to order</u>) requiring the following actions, effective Monday April 29<sup>th</sup>:

- Mandatory testing for interstate movement of dairy cattle Prior to interstate movement, lactating dairy cattle are required to receive a negative test for Influenza A virus at an approved National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) laboratory.
- Mandatory Reporting laboratories and state veterinarians must report positive Influenza A
  nucleic acid detection diagnostic results (e.g. PCR or genetic sequencing) and positive Influenza
  A serology results in livestock to USDA APHIS.
