Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Non-Domestic Ruminant Type Animals

(Exotic Antelope, Sheep, Goats, etc. not to include Cervidae)

An Import Permit is required.

Official identification is required and must be listed on the CVI.

USDA 840 EID tag

USDA metal NUES tag

Microchip

Breed registration tattoo (The entire tattoo number must be

listed)

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
