
## **Rabies Exposure Guidelines** DOMESTIC ANIMAL **Bitten or Scratched** by rabies suspect **Veterinary Examination** Suspect animal test positive for rabies or not available for testing Non-current rabies History of rabies Current rabies vaccination with vaccination without No rabies vaccination appropriate vaccination vaccination history appropriate vaccination documentation documentation Immediate euthanasia Booster and owner **Prospective Serological** observe for 45 days Monitoring - See NASPHV Protocol **Euthanasia Refused** 1. Vaccinate within 96 hours of exposure 2. Strict quarantine/isolation a. 4 months for dogs & cats Test if animal becomes ill or b. 6 months for ferrets dies during observation
