Ram Epididymitis

Brucella ovis



CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) is required.

Official Identification: (Scrapie Tag or Breed Registration Tattoo).

Must be listed on the CVI.

Importation of breeding Rams:

All Rams ≥ 6 mo. – A negative test for *B. ovis* is required within 30 days before entering the state.

Test results and date must be entered on the CVI.

Exceptions for testing

Rams ≥ 6 mo. Originating from a **Brucella ovis-free flock**.

Must be certified by the state of origin, having equal requirements as SD.

Exceptions to CVI & Import Permit

Rams are moving directly to slaughter.

Intrastate Movement:

Rams ≥ 6 mo. Sold, loaned, or leased

A negative Brucella ovis test is required within 90 days of movement.

Exception:

Originating from a **B. ovis-free flock**.

Rams \geq 6 mo. sold for immediate slaughter.

Positive – Brucella ovis Rams (Intrastate Movement Only)

Must be identified with an Official Tag. (9 CFR Part 79)

Must remain Quarantined until moved directly to slaughter.

Feeder Rams

No test is required.

No feeder Ram may be used for breeding without meeting the testing requirements for breeding Rams.
