

Bovine - Rodeo/Recreational



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Official ID required for all cattle imported, and must be listed on the CVI

USDA 840 EID Tag

USDA Metal NUES Tag if applied before Nov 5, 2024

Trichomoniasis Requirements

All non-virgin bulls must have a negative Trich test

Exception: The bulls are confined to prevent breeding

Testing Requirements

Tuberculosis:

All rodeo/recreational cattle must have a negative TB test conducted by a US-accredited veterinarian within 12 months of importation

Rodeo/Recreational cattle include all cattle imported to South Dakota for recreational purposes, including rodeo events, roping events, cattle cutting events, cattle penning events, steer wrestling events, and training for such events.

Cattle moving from an area that is not accredited as free of Bovine Tuberculosis

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas -- DSA (Greater Yellowstone Area)
