

Scrapie Control



South Dakota is declared a scrapie control and eradication state in cooperation with USDA APHIS.

Producers and individuals involved in buying, selling, or transporting shall adhere to state requirements to maintain consistent state status by adhering to the following:

1. Official Identification – Scrapie Identification Tags or Breed Registration Tattoo
