Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Feeding Animals

An Import Permit is required when using a paper or non-approved electronic CVI.

Official Identification is required

Scrapie Identification Tags

USDA 840 EID Tag

Breed Registration Tattoo (The entire tattoo number must be listed)

Rams 6 months of age and older for breeding purposes

Negative test for <u>RAM EPIDIDYMITIS</u> (Brucella Ovis) by ELISA test 30 days before entering the state.

Exception: Rams originating from a Brucella ovis-free flock, tested within 12 months, before entering the state.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
