

# ***Sheep and Goats—Domestic***

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



**A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE**

## **Feeding Animals**

An Import Permit is required when using a paper or non-approved electronic CVI.

Official Identification is required

Scrapie Identification Tags

USDA 840 EID Tag

Breed Registration Tattoo (The entire tattoo number must be listed)

## **Rams 6 months of age and older for breeding purposes**

Negative test for RAM EPIDIDYMITIS (Brucella Ovis) by ELISA test 30 days before entering the state.

**Exception:** Rams originating from a Brucella ovis-free flock, tested within 12 months, before entering the state.

**No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.**

**No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an approved auction market.**
