# Tuberculosis Requirements



## **Cattle and Goats**

No Testing is required for animals originating from an Accredited Free State or Zone.

All animals originating from a TB Modified-Accredited State or Zone -

Must be moving from a non-quarantined herd.

Official tuberculin negative test within 60 days before movement. All animals intended for breeding –

Official tuberculin negative test within 60 days before movement.

#### **AND**

Originating from a herd having an official negative TB test within the last 12 months.

Official identification and official test dates must be listed on the CVI.

## Cattle

Meet USDA, APHIS Bovine Tuberculosis Eradication Uniform Methods and Rules.

## **Recreational and Rodeo Animals:**

A negative TB test is required within the last 12 months.

#### Cervidae

#### **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection** and **Import Permit** is required.

All Cervidae must originate from an accredited herd with completed testing requirements within 24 months of movement.

### OR

All Cervidae must meet both requirements: originate from a herd having been officially whole herd TB tested negative within 12 months, and an individual tested negative within 90 days of movement.

**Exception:** No individual test is required if the official whole herd negative test has occurred within six months of movement.
