

# ***Tuberculosis Requirements***



## **Cattle and Goats**

**No Testing is required for animals originating from an Accredited Free State or Zone.**

**All animals originating from a TB Modified-Accredited State or Zone -**

**Must be moving from a non-quarantined herd.**

**Official tuberculin negative test within 60 days before movement. All animals intended for breeding –**

**Official tuberculin negative test within 60 days before movement.**

**AND**

**Originating from a herd having an official negative TB test within the last 12 months.**

**Official identification and official test dates must be listed on the CVI.**

## **Cattle**

**Appendix A**

## **Recreational and Rodeo Animals:**

**A negative TB test is required within the last 12 months.**

---

## **Cervidae**

**Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and Import Permit is required.**

**All Cervidae must originate from an accredited herd with completed testing requirements within 24 months of movement.**

**OR**

**All Cervidae must meet both requirements: originate from a herd having been officially whole herd TB tested negative within 12 months, and an individual tested negative within 90 days of movement.**

**Exception: No individual test is required if the official whole herd negative test has occurred within six months of movement.**
