Beef (Cattle/Bison)

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Feeders (to include Beef-Dairy cross)

Less than 18 months of age – No official identification is required.

Intact animals over 18 months of age – Official identification is required.

Intact bulls - <u>Trichomoniasis testing</u> is required unless confined to prevent breeding.

Breeding Animals

Pre-weaned calves moving with Dams can travel under the Dam's ID and testing requirements.

Calves 2 months of age and older for breeding purposes not accompanied by the dam—Official identification is required.

Must indicate the status - virgin, bred, calf at side, or open.

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas—<u>DSA</u> (Greater Yellowstone Area)

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
