Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Canadian and Mexican Origin

All bovines must comply with Federal requirements for entry. (9 C.F.R. 93.418)

Cattle entering for breeding purposes must meet <u>Trichomoniasis</u> requirements (Click the link to see the section).

Mexican Origin

All bovines must have a negative Tuberculosis test conducted by a USDA-accredited veterinarian within 60 days before entry into South Dakota. (9 C.F.R 93.427)

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
