## Additional Requirements or Exceptions



## A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

No Import Permit required.

Animals are restricted from travel into the state if

Animals are under quarantine for rabies.

Animals are experiencing signs of communicable, contagious, or infectious disease.

Proof of a current <u>Rabies Vaccination</u> is required for animals <u>three</u> months of age and older.

No Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required if Dogs and Cats travel with their owner and remain in the state for less than 30 days.

Domestic and International travel information: Fly With My Pet

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
