Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

EECVI (Extended Equine Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) is accepted.
No Import Permit is required.

A negative Coggins or ELISA EIA (Equine Infectious Anemia) test is required within 12 months before entry.

Exceptions:

Native horses originating from North Dakota.

Foals traveling with their dam.

Canadian Origin

USDA import requirements must be met ([9 C.F.R 93.317](#)),

AND

A South Dakota Import Permit is required.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an approved auction market.
