Grazing Cattle



CHECK WITH THE STATE OF ORIGIN FOR SPECIFIC RETURN REQUIRMENTS

>>>>Import to South Dakota from an Adjacent State<<<<

This applies to cattle imported into South Dakota for temporary grazing originating from: IA, MN, MT, ND, NE, or WY.

Limited to 180 days.

Must include the 911 address, GPS coordinates, or a physical description of the SD destination.

Official Identification is required and must be listed on the CVI

Registered herd brand is accepted -

For Brand questions, refer to the **SD Brand Board**. 605-773-3324

Pre-weaned calves traveling with their dam may travel without official identification.

Trichomoniasis Requirements apply

Bulls must have virgin status or a negative test before breeding. Must be stated on the CVI.

Cows/heifers must have a virgin status, be confirmed pregnant, or be moving with their pre-weaned calf at their side.

Must be stated on the CVI.

Required statements on CVI

"Cattle will remain in South Dakota less than 180 days."

AND

"No change of cattle ownership will occur while grazing in South Dakota."

AND

"No commingling with other livestock/cattle will occur while grazing in South Dakota."
