# Ram Epididymitis



## Brucella ovis

CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) is required.

Official Identification: (Scrapie Tag or Breed Registration Tattoo).

Must be listed on the CVI.

### Importation of breeding Rams:

All Rams ≥ 6 mo. – A negative test for *B. ovis* is required within 30 days before entering the state.

Test results and date must be entered on the CVI.

#### **Exceptions for testing**

Rams ≥ 6 mo. Originating from a *Brucella ovis*-free flock.

Must be certified by the state of origin having equal requirements as SD.

#### **Exceptions to CVI & Import Permit**

Rams moving directly to slaughter.

#### **Intrastate Movement:**

Rams ≥ 6 mo. Sold, loaned, or leased

A negative *Brucella ovis* test is required within 90 days of movement.

**Exception:** 

Originating from a *B. ovis*-free flock.

Rams  $\geq$  6 mo. sold for immediate slaughter.

**Positive – Brucella ovis Rams** (Intrastate Movement Only)

Must be Identified with an Official Tag. (9 CFR Part 79)

Must remain Quarantined until moved directly to slaughter.

#### **Feeder Rams**

No test is required.

No feeder Ram may be used for breeding without meeting the testing requirements for breeding Rams.
