Ruminants—Other

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Camels, Llamas, and Alpacas

An Import Permit is required when using a paper or non-approved electronic CVI.

Official identification is required and must be listed on the CVI.

Non-Domestic Ruminant Type Animals (Exotic Antelope, Sheep, Goats, etc... Not to include Cervidae)

Import Permit is required.

Official identification is required and must be listed on the CVI.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
