Sheep and Goats—Domestic

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

An Import Permit is required when using a paper or non-approved electronic CVI.

Official Identification is required.

Scrapie Identification Tags

OR

Breed Registration Tattoo (to be official must list the entire tattoo number)

Rams 6 months of age and older for breeding purposes

Negative test for <u>RAM EPIDIDYMITIS</u> (*BRUCELLA OVIS*) by ELISA test 30 days before entering the state.

Exception: Originating from a *Brucella ovis-free* flock tested within 12 months before entering the state.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
