Swine—Foreign Imports

Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Canadian Swine

All swine must comply with federal requirements for entry. (9 C.F.R. 93.516)

USDA import requirements must be met, AND

A South Dakota Import Permit is required.

Breeding and Feeding Swine

Official Identification is required and must be listed on the CVI.

Feeding Swine

A provincial government-assigned herd mark (premises #, tattoo, or tag) may be used if ALL animals originate from that premises.

Pseudorabies-vaccinated swine are not eligible for entry into South Dakota.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an <u>approved auction market</u>.
