

Tuberculosis

Requirements



Cattle and Goats

No Testing is required for animals originating from an Accredited Free State or Zone.

All animals originating from a TB Modified-Accredited State or Zone -

Must be moving from a non-quarantined herd.

Official tuberculin tested negative within 60 days before movement.

All animals intended for breeding –

Official tuberculin tested negative within 60 days before movement.

AND

Originated from a herd having an official negative TB test within the last 12 months.

Official identification and official test dates must be listed on the CVI.

Cattle

Meet USDA, APHIS Bovine Tuberculosis Eradication Uniform Methods and Rules.

Appendix A

Recreational and Rodeo Animals:

A negative TB test is required within the last 12 months.

Cervidae

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and Import Permit are required.

All Cervidae must originate from an accredited herd with completed testing requirements within 24 months of movement.

OR

All Cervidae must meet both requirements: originate from a herd having been officially whole herd TB tested negative within 12 months, and an individual tested negative within 90 days of movement.

Exception: No individual test is required if the official whole herd negative test has occurred within six months of movement.
