Additional Requirements or Exceptions



A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE STATE

Special Announcements

All breeding age dairy 18 months of age or older moving into SD are required to have an import permit number listed on the certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI).

Feeders

Spayed heifers and steers

Official identification is required but not required to be listed on the CVI.

Include this statement on the CVI: "All animals are officially identified."

Breeding Animals

All sexually intact dairy cattle of any age

Official identification is required and is to be listed on the CVI.

See Trichomoniasis and Tuberculosis Requirements.

Status indication is required – virgin, bred, calf at side, or open.

Cattle moving from the Designated Surveillance Areas—DSA

(Greater Yellowstone Area)

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock moving directly to an approved slaughter facility.

No CVI or Import Permit is required for livestock (except Equine) moving directly from a farm/ranch in a neighboring state to an approved auction market.
